




Leaving a Legacy

We always recommend that you seek advice from a solicitor when you make or change your will.

Thank you for wanting to benefit paddle steamers by leaving a legacy for the Paddle Steamer Preservation Society. Gifts made to charities in a will are exempt from Inheritance Tax.

The following are examples of wording you might use in your will for the three main types of legacy.

A residuary legacy

I devise and bequeath _____ (insert 'all' or whatever fractional share of your estate you wish to bequeath) of the residue of my estate to The Paddle Steamer Preservation Society, Mayfield, Hoe Lane, Abinger Hammer, Dorking, RH5 6RS, a charity registered in England & Wales (298328) and in Scotland (SC037603), hereinafter called the Charity, such a sum to be applied to the general purposes of the Charity, and I direct that a receipt from the Treasurer or other authorised officer for the time being of the Charity shall be good and sufficient discharge to my Executors for the receipt of this legacy.

A pecuniary legacy

I bequeath to The Paddle Steamer Preservation Society, Mayfield, Hoe Lane, Abinger Hammer, Dorking, RH5 6RS, a charity registered in England & Wales (298328) and in Scotland (SC037603), hereinafter called the Charity, free of tax the sum of £_____ to be applied to the general purposes of the Charity and I direct that a receipt from the Treasurer or other authorised officer for the time being of the Charity shall be good and sufficient discharge to my Executors for the payment of this legacy.

A specific legacy I bequeath to The Paddle Steamer Preservation Society, Mayfield, Hoe Lane, Abinger Hammer, Dorking, RH5 6RS, a charity registered in England & Wales (298328) and in Scotland (SC037603), hereinafter called the Charity free of tax

_____ (clear description of the item(s) to be bequeathed) with the full power to realise such assets and to apply the proceeds to the general purposes of the Charity, and I direct that a receipt from the Treasurer or other authorised officer for the time being of the Charity shall be good and sufficient discharge to my Executors for the receipt of this legacy.

These forms of wording enable you to make a legacy to the Society's general purposes. If you would like to give to a specific area you can earmark your legacy. The words "general purposes of the Charity" may be amended to take account of your particular wishes.
